## **Committee Reports**

### **Other**

Jonathan Gillentine gave a report on the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Review committee for illiteracy reading language arts, which he co-chaired. He wanted to express his appreciation to the board for giving him leadership opportunities that he was able to achieve by serving on the board previously. He mentioned that the committee has already had one (1) meeting and the things the committee are looking at are really exciting not only in illiteracy but it also branches out since all standards talk about reflection and professionalism. He also talked about how the committee had to be careful of their words since they are trying to make it timeless yet current so that it will apply in the next ten (10) years. The committee does meet on a monthly basis thru February 2011 and the co-chairs will be presenting the standards to the NBPTS itself in April 2011.

Lynn Hammonds gave a report on the NASDTEC Meeting she attended. She reported that the Professional Fitness Institute meeting was centered on teacher

misconduct and how almost every other board had a staff attorney working full-time, focused on these kinds of topics as well as investigators. She reported that our main job is to protect children through having competent teachers in the classroom who are not going to harm children in any way. But now there seems to be a lot of new ways teachers are getting themselves into trouble and the main one is through the Internet and NASDTEC has regular meetings about these kinds of issues, which they call the "Slippery Slope". It talks about how teachers first get into that situation by befriending their children on facebook. NASDTEC talked about how each state should have training on these kinds of matters so that teachers know where to draw the line.

Ruth Silberstein reported that each state handles their teachers misconduct differently but the majority of the states have their own investigative team so that if there were an incident that happened on or off campus that team would handle it. We should be aware of the interpersonal relationship between teacher and student especially when teachers start setting children up for inappropriate behaviors. A red flag goes up when a teacher keeps calling in a particular child all the time. Steve Miyasato, board member asked: "as a principal of a school, what kind of suggestions if any did they give as clues to look for when you suspect inappropriate behavior"? Ruth Silberstein replied by saying that NASDTEC suggested educating the entire staff so that no one is singled out. They suggested that teachers need to speak out more. Wait for the police to come to investigate and never threaten the child. They also suggested that these professional fitness issues should really start in the teacher education programs and so the board may want to consider this for the Teacher Education Committee to look at.

Carolyn Gyuran, Educational Specialist reported on the NBPTS meeting she attended. She reported on the "Take One" program and how teachers can do one portfolio on any subject, turn it in to NBPTS and see what they score as a trial just to see how the program works. A whole school tried this and scored high even though the school was considered a "struggling" school. But because everyone collaborated with each other they were able to keep the scores up for the whole school. Federal monies of \$20,000 were awarded and 61 candidates were able to take advantage of this subsidy so far.

### **Testimony, Petitions from the Public**

Jonathan Gillentine urged the board to consider maintaining some grasp on the National Board Candidate support session program. He mentioned the importance on a large scale of things when it comes to the new INTASC standards as well as the other initiatives coming forward like some of the federal reforms and he felt it would be prudent of the board to maintain that grasp. Turning it over to another body would not give the board insight on accomplished teaching and promoting the profession.

## New Business:

### 1. NBI 10-08 Rev.: Draft Language for Delegation of Powers

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following revision to their Administrative Rules concerning delegation of powers:

§8-54-17 Delegation of Powers. The Board delegates authority to the Executive Director to complete the following actions. All delegated actions will be presented to the Board at their next regularly scheduled meeting.

Grant initial licenses, added fields and permits when the following criteria have been met:

- (1) All forms, tests and documentation for meeting licensing and permit requirements have been submitted by the applicant and received by HTSB, and
- (2) Forms and documentation are complete, and
- (3) There are no professional fitness issues, and
- (4) ~~(4)~~ All fees have been paid.

Grant license and permit renewals when the following criteria have been met:

- (1) All forms and documentation for meeting renewal requirements have been submitted by the applicant and received by HTSB, and
- (2) Forms and documentation are complete, and
- (3) There are no professional fitness issues, and
- (4) All fees have been paid.

~~Immediately suspend the license or permit of an individual who has:~~

- ~~(1) Been arrested for a violent crime against a person.~~
- ~~(2) Been arrested for distribution of drugs to minors.~~
- ~~(3) Been arrested for a sexual crime against a child.~~
- ~~(4) Not paid their his/her fees when due.~~

The individual may present their his/her case to the Board through the contested case procedure.

## 2. NBI 10-09 Rev.: Revision of Administrative Rules to Outline License Renewal Audit Procedure

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following revision to their Administrative Rules concerning audit of license renewals:

§8-54-9

~~(c) Teaching licenses expiring [2008] July 1, 2010 and later. Licensees whose five-year licenses expire on [June 30] July 1 [2008] [2009] 2010 or later shall [submit a professional growth plan by a date established by the board. The professional growth plan shall be submitted in a format and manner established by the board and shall comply with the procedure described in §8 54 9(b) above.~~

~~Failure to: 1) submit a professional growth plan by the dates established by the board; or 2) submit documentation and report of completion of the professional growth plan in a format and manner established by the board and at least six months prior to the expiration date of the license, shall result in the licensee having to meet the initial licensing requirements in effect at the time and submit:~~

- ~~i) an application for initial license;~~
- ~~ii) all documents and any other information required by the board; and~~
- ~~iii) any initial license application fee/s established by the board.~~

~~All documentation and reports must ] meet the guidelines set by the board. Acceptance of the licensee's documentation [and report] shall result in a five-year license renewal, provided the licensee has paid the necessary fees specified by the board.~~

~~[If a licensee's documentation and report are not accepted, the board may allow the licensee one additional opportunity to produce appropriate documentation and report of the completion of his/her professional growth plan. The board's decision after this second submittal shall be final.]~~

The board will conduct an audit between July 1 and August 31 of each year beginning July 1, 2011;

Ten percent of renewals, not to exceed two hundred annually, will be drawn from those renewals occurring between July 1 to June 30 of the previous school year;

Licensees will submit documentation for audit in a manner prescribed by the board;

An independent, external organization will may be contracted by the board to evaluate the renewals and their compliance with the criteria of meeting the Teacher Performance Standards and satisfactory experience and report to the board. They will may also provide information on methods used to meet Teacher Performance Standards and feedback on the effectiveness of the renewal process.

If a licensee is found not to be in compliance as a result of the audit, disciplinary action on the license may occur.

If a licensee wishes to contest the board's decision, he or she may pursue the matter in the circuit court of the State of Hawaii in the circuit where the licensee resides, or in the First Circuit Court of the State of Hawaii if the licensee resides outside of the State of Hawaii.

### **3. NBI 10-17: Cases 10-03 and 10-04**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the Interim Executive Director's recommendations on Cases 10-03 and 10-04.

### **4. NBI 10-18: Revision of Personnel Specialist and Educational Specialist Job Descriptions**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the attached revisions to the job descriptions for the Personnel Specialist II and Educational Specialist II and instructs the Executive Director to begin the revision process with the Office of Human Resources.

The Board makes these revisions because supervision of the Licensing Section and investigation of Professional Fitness matters has become much more comprehensive in scope than when it was assigned in 2002 due to the numbers of applications and Professional Fitness cases. License renewal should also be the responsibility of the Personnel Specialist as the Licensing Section processes renewals and all Section clerks report to the Personnel Specialist.

With these revisions, the Personnel Specialist would have responsibility for all licensing operations, including supervision of the Licensing Section, and the Educational Specialist would have responsibility for coordination with outside agencies and institutions for S.A.T.E., NCATE, Praxis testing, professional development, NASDTEC Interstate Agreement, and Title II.

## **5. NBI 10-19 Rev.: License Expiration Date**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following change to all Hawaii teaching license expiration dates based on advice from the Attorney General for personal privacy issues:

- All current and future license and permit expiration dates will be modified to expire on June 30 following the current expiration date listed on the license record.

AND

- Online records will be updated by Hawaii Information Consortium (HIC).
- Since the online license is the official license and this record will be updated by HIC, teachers will receive a new printed license at their next renewal.
- Teachers will not incur additional fees because of this change.

Licensed teachers, the Hawaii Department of Education, Charter School Administrative Office, the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools and Hawaii State Teachers Association will be notified within thirty days.

## **6. NBI 10-21 Rev.: Praxis Pre-Professional Skills Test Composite Score**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following regarding the Praxis Pre-Professional Skills Test Composite Score:

The Board will accept only passing PPST Reading, Mathematics and Writing passing scores for tests taken July 1, 2011 and after. Current passing scores are: PPST Reading: 172; PPST Mathematics: 173; PPST Writing: 171. Composite scores will not be accepted for tests taken after July 1, 2011.

This change is in alignment with federal Title II reporting requirements.

## **7. NBI 10-23: Approval of Hawaii Provisional Licenses, Standard Licenses, Advanced Licenses, Added Fields to Existing Licenses, Renewed Licenses, and Career and Technical Education Special Permits**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the issuance of Provisional Hawaii licenses, Standard Hawaii licenses, Advanced Licenses, Added Fields to existing licenses, and Career and Technical Education Special Permits as indicated on the attached list.

The Board approves issuing a renewed license for teachers as indicated on the attached lists showing those who have met the criteria.

The HTSB also approves any necessary correction by staff for clerical errors. License field(s) and level(s) may not be corrected, but must be resubmitted to the Board for approval.

**8. NBI 10-24: Case 10-05**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the Executive Director's recommendations on Case 10-05.
