The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following for the Hawaii Pacific University Teacher Education Program in Elementary Education based on the Board's State Approved Teacher Education (SATE) Program Review Team's review on November 5, 2009:

The program is granted provisional approval status for the Undergraduate, Post-baccalaureate and Master's Programs in Elementary Education leading to licensure in Elementary Education K-6, effective December 17, 2009 through December 31, 2013.

A review by the Association for Childhood Education International (ACEI) or the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) must be completed ~~no later than one year after completion of the Programs' first cohort or~~ by December 31, 2013, ~~whichever comes earlier.~~

The Unit must explain any changes to these programs in the Unit's Annual Report due each year to HTSB by December 31.

A letter shall be sent to the Hawaii Pacific University School of Education on behalf of the Board to communicate this action.

TITLE: License and Permit Fee Structure Revision

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following revision effective July 1, 2011, to the license and permit fee structure:

1. Licensees with an effective license date July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2016 have one of the following options for payment of their license fees via the automated HTSB checkout system on www.htsb.org using a credit card or eCheck:

a. Make full payment of the license/renewal fee of \$240.00 at the time of licensure or renewal for the new five-year license period. The licensee will pay the online processing fee.

OR

b. Make yearly payments of the license/renewal fee of \$48.00 by June 30th of each year of the license. The licensee will pay the online processing fee.

2. Licensees with an effective license date July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2016 may make full payment of the license fee of \$480.00 by cashier's check or money order, payable to the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board, mailed or presented to the HTSB office. No processing fee will be assessed.

3. Emergency hires with an effective permit date of July 1, 2011 will make full payment of \$48.00 for payment of their one-year emergency hire permit via the automated HTSB checkout system on www.htsb.org using a credit card or eCheck. The licensee will pay the online processing fee.

4. Licensees and permittees with an effective date on or after July 1, 2016 must:

a. Make full payment of the license or permit fee at time of license issuance or renewal;

AND

b. Use the online system to pay their license and permit fees, including the online processing fee, via the automatic HTSB checkout system on www.htsb.org using a credit card or eCheck.

Note: HTSB does not retain any portion of the online processing fee.

TITLE: Advanced License Fee Payments

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following regarding payment of the ten-year Advanced License fee payment effective immediately:

1. Licensees with an effective license date July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2016 have one of the following options for payment of their license fees via the automated HTSB checkout system on www.htsb.org using a credit card or eCheck:

a. Make full payment of the license fee of \$480.00 at the time of licensure or renewal for the new ten-year license period. The licensee will pay the online processing fee;

OR

b. Make two payments of \$240.00 each at the time of licensure and by June 30th of the fifth year of the license. The licensee will pay the online processing fee;

OR

c. Make yearly payments of the first five years of the license fee of \$48.00 by June 30th of each year. At year five, the remainder of the fee will be due. The licensee will pay the online processing fee.

2. Licensees with an effective license date July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2016 may make full payment of the license fee of \$480.00 by cashier's check or money order, payable to the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board, mailed or presented to the HTSB office. No processing fee will be assessed.

3. Licensees with an effective date on or after July 1, 2016 must:

a. Make full payment of the license fee at time of license issuance or renewal;

AND

b. Use the online system to pay their license fees, including the online processing fee, via the automatic HTSB checkout system on www.htsb.org using a credit card or eCheck.

TITLE: Revision of State Approval of Teacher Education Review Process for Provisional Unit and Program Reviews

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following revisions for provisional review of new State Approved Teacher Education Units and Programs effective immediately:

- A Letter of Intent must be submitted to the Board.
- US Department of Education guidelines for approval of new teacher preparation programs and Hawaii Department of Education shortage areas will be factored into the approval priority for the review of applications.
- After acceptance of the Letter of Intent, ~~the unit or program the applicant~~ will be assessed the following fees prior to scheduling the review:
 - New unit: \$1,000
 - ~~Each Nnew program~~ license field: \$500
- A provisional review will be scheduled no sooner than six months but no later than 1 year from the Board's acceptance of the letter of intent no later than January 1 for any unit or program review to be scheduled between the following July 1 and June 30..
- All review materials must be submitted in electronic format as specified by the Board;
- Reviews will be conducted via HTSB's selected virtual platform;
- There will be one team assigned to review both the unit and all license fields.
- The provisional unit and license field ~~program~~ review teams will consist of a minimum of the following:
 - One HTSB staff;
 - One State Approved Teacher Education Program (SATEP) faculty member, who is from a Hawaii based SATEP or a reviewer for a national teacher education accrediting body;
 - One P-12 teacher who is licensed ~~in the~~ appropriately field for each license field ~~the program(s)~~ being reviewed.
 - Other personnel as appropriate
- New programs may not be implemented until they receive approval.

Rationale:

Since HTSB has already taken steps to become self-sufficient. The cost of provisional SATE reviews must be factored into the process. The fee will go toward providing substitute teachers on the review team; the cost of the online platform used for the reviews; and cost of materials.

TITLE: Halau Wanana Request to Defer Review

~~Halau Wanana is seeking national accreditation from the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) and needs additional time to conduct the review.~~ The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves a request from Halau Wanana Indigenous Teacher Education Program to defer their review. The Board approves deferral until Spring, 2013 with the following conditions. ~~until Fall Semester 2012. Halau Wanana is seeking national accreditation from the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) and needs additional time to conduct the review.~~

The following conditions shall apply:

- Until new HTSB SATE approval is granted, Halau Wanana will continue the condition set in their previous extension, ~~(NBI 10-55 Revised)~~ and not admit any new candidates to their program until they attain full SATE approval from HTSB.
- Halau Wanana will submit ~~a quarterly reports~~ to HTSB by January 1, 2012, ~~April 1, 2012,~~ July 1, 2012 and ~~September 1, 2012~~ , **January 1, 2013, and July 1, 2013** on their progress toward TEAC accreditation. ~~Should the program fail to submit any report their provisional approval will lapse;~~
- Halau Wanana must provide verification from TEAC of initial submission of Inquiry Brief Proposal on or before April 1, 2012.
- Halau Wanana must provide verification from TEAC of acceptance of an auditable Inquiry Brief Proposal on or before October 1, 2012.
- Halau Wanana must provide verification from TEAC of a scheduled on site review to occur no later than April 1, 2013.
- Halau Wanana must submit evidence of TEAC accreditation no later than ~~May~~ **October** 1, 2013. ~~Should the program fail to submit any report their provisional approval will lapse;~~
- Should the program fail to attain national accreditation by the specified date their provisional approval will lapse;
- Should the program fail to submit any report or verification required above their provisional approval will lapse on the date following the missed deadline.
- HTSB SATE provisional approval is extended to ~~June 30~~ **October 1**, 2013 on the condition the program meets all other requirements.

TITLE: Approval of Out of State Teacher Education Programs Operating in Hawaii

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following for out of state teacher education programs operating in Hawaii:

Teacher education programs which are approved to prepare teacher candidates for licensure in their home state and have a physical or virtual presence in Hawaii (not including individuals who are completing an out of state SATEP under the supervision of a Hawai'i SATEP) must meet the following criteria:

- The program must have both approval to operate as a State Approved Teacher Preparation Program in its home state and national accreditation from a body approved to accredit teacher preparation programs by the US Department of Education;
- The program must pay a registration fee of \$500.00 and register its presence with the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board by a means determined by the HTSB staff, to include a description of the programs, copy of official approval status in the home state, copy of official national accreditation status and a list of current activities in Hawaii;
- The program must submit an annual report by December 31st updating any changes to the program including information about current accreditation status;
- Programs with approval in their home state but without national accreditation must submit a letter of intent to the HTSB and go through the Hawaii SATE process.
- The Executive Director shall notify other state agencies through the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC) of this policy within thirty days.

TITLE: Approval of New Educational Testing Service Praxis Licensure Test for Reading Specialist

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following revisions to its Praxis test requirements:

1. HTSB discontinues the use of the following Praxis II test as the official content licensure test for the Reading Specialist license effective August 1, 2013:

Current Test to be Discontinued Effective August 1, 2013	Test Code	Passing Score	License Field
Reading Specialist	300	540	Reading Specialist, all levels

2. HTSB will accept passing scores for the above tests *taken* prior to August 1, 2013. HTSB allows one year for overlap of old and new tests for candidates and SATEP to integrate information into their programs.
3. HTSB approves the following new Praxis II tests effective August 1, 2012:

Hawaii Librarian Standards*

***Adopted from the American Library Association (ALA) American Association of School Librarians (AASL)**

ALA/AASL Standards for Initial Preparation of School Librarians (2010)

Approved by Specialty Areas Studies Board (SASB) of the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE), October 24, 2010

The ALA/AASL Standards for Initial Preparation of School Librarians apply to all master's programs that prepare candidates to develop and manage library and information services in a PreK-12 setting, regardless of degree name or professional title. "School librarian" is the official professional title adopted by the American Association of School Librarians (AASL) and the American Library Association. Other titles include, but are not limited to, "school library media specialist," "teacher librarian," "library information specialist," and "media coordinator."

Standard 1: Teaching for Learning

Candidates are effective teachers who demonstrate knowledge of learners and learning and who model and promote collaborative planning, instruction in multiple literacies, and inquiry-based learning, enabling members of the learning community to become effective users and creators of ideas and information. Candidates design and implement instruction that engages students' interests and develops their ability to inquire, think critically, gain and share knowledge.

1.1 Knowledge of learners and learning

Candidates are knowledgeable of learning styles, stages of human growth and development, and cultural influences on learning. Candidates assess learner needs and design instruction that reflects educational best practice. Candidates support the learning of all students and other members of the learning community, including those with diverse learning styles, physical and intellectual abilities and needs. Candidates base twenty-first century skills instruction on student interests and learning needs and link it to the assessment of student achievement.

1.2 Effective and knowledgeable teacher

Candidates implement the principles of effective teaching and learning that contribute to an active, inquiry-based approach to learning. Candidates make use of a variety of instructional strategies and assessment tools to design and develop digital-age learning experiences and assessments in partnership with classroom teachers and other educators. Candidates can document and communicate the impact of collaborative instruction on student achievement.

1.3 Instructional partner

Candidates model, share, and promote effective principles of teaching and learning as collaborative partners with other educators. Candidates acknowledge the importance of participating in curriculum development, of engaging in school improvement processes, and of offering professional development to other

educators as it relates to library and information use.

1.4 Integration of twenty-first century skills and learning standards

Candidates advocate for twenty-first century literacy skills to support the learning needs of the school community. Candidates demonstrate how to collaborate with other teachers to plan and implement instruction of the *AASL Standards for the 21st-Century Learner* and state student curriculum standards. Candidates employ strategies to integrate multiple literacies with content curriculum. Candidates integrate the use of emerging technologies as a means for effective and creative teaching and to support P-12 students' conceptual understanding, critical thinking and creative processes.

Standard 2: Literacy and Reading

Candidates promote reading for learning, personal growth, and enjoyment. Candidates are aware of major trends in children's and young adult literature and select reading materials in multiple formats to support reading for information, reading for pleasure, and reading for lifelong learning. Candidates use a variety of strategies to reinforce classroom reading instruction to address the diverse needs and interests of all readers.

Elements

2.1 Literature

Candidates are familiar with a wide range of children's, young adult, and professional literature in multiple formats and languages to support reading for information, reading for pleasure, and reading for lifelong learning.

2.2 Reading promotion

Candidates use a variety of strategies to promote leisure reading and model personal enjoyment of reading in order to promote habits of creative expression and lifelong reading.

2.3 Respect for diversity

Candidates demonstrate the ability to develop a collection of reading and information materials in print and digital formats that support the diverse developmental, cultural, social, and linguistic needs of P-12 students and their communities.

2.4 Literacy strategies

Candidates collaborate with classroom teachers to reinforce a wide variety of reading instructional strategies to ensure P-12 students are able to create meaning from text.

Standard 3: Information and Knowledge

Candidates model and promote ethical, equitable access to and use of physical, digital, and virtual collections of resources. Candidates demonstrate knowledge of a variety of information sources and services that support the needs of the diverse learning

community. Candidates demonstrate the use of a variety of research strategies to generate knowledge to improve practice.

Elements

3.1 Efficient and ethical information-seeking behavior

Candidates identify and provide support for diverse student information needs. Candidates model multiple strategies for students, other teachers, and administrators to locate, evaluate, and ethically use information for specific purposes. Candidates collaborate with students, other teachers, and administrators to efficiently access, interpret, and communicate information.

3.2 Access to information

Candidates support flexible, open access for library services. Candidates demonstrate their ability to develop solutions for addressing physical, social and intellectual barriers to equitable access to resources and services. Candidates facilitate access to information in print, non-print, and digital formats. Candidates model and communicate the legal and ethical codes of the profession.

3.3 Information technology

Candidates demonstrate their ability to design and adapt relevant learning experiences that engage students in authentic learning through the use of digital tools and resources. Candidates model and facilitate the effective use of current and emerging digital tools to locate, analyze, evaluate, and use information resources to support research, learning, creating, and communicating in a digital society.

3.4 Research and knowledge creation

Candidates use evidence-based, action research to collect data. Candidates interpret and use data to create and share new knowledge to improve practice in school libraries

Standard 4: Advocacy and Leadership

Candidates advocate for dynamic school library programs and positive learning environments that focus on student learning and achievement by collaborating and connecting with teachers, administrators, librarians, and the community. Candidates are committed to continuous learning and professional growth and lead professional development activities for other educators. Candidates provide leadership by articulating ways in which school libraries contribute to student achievement.

Elements

4.1. Networking with the library community

Candidates demonstrate the ability to establish connections with other libraries and to strengthen cooperation among library colleagues for resource sharing, networking, and facilitating access to information. Candidates participate and collaborate as members of a social and intellectual network of learners.

4.2 Professional development

Candidates model a strong commitment to the profession by participating in professional growth and leadership opportunities through membership in library associations, attendance at professional conferences, reading professional publications, and exploring Internet resources. Candidates plan for ongoing professional growth.

4.3 Leadership

Candidates are able to articulate the role and relationship of the school library program's impact on student academic achievement within the context of current educational initiatives. Utilizing evidence-based practice and information from education and library research, candidates communicate ways in which the library program can enhance school improvement efforts.

4.4 Advocacy Candidates identify stakeholders within and outside the school community who

impact the school library program. Candidates develop a plan to advocate for school library and information programs, resources, and services.

Standard 5: Program Management and Administration

Candidates plan, develop, implement, and evaluate school library programs, resources, and services in support of the mission of the library program within the school according to the ethics and principles of library science, education, management, and administration.

Elements

5.1 Collections

Candidates evaluate and select print, non-print, and digital resources using professional selection tools and evaluation criteria to develop and manage a quality collection designed to meet the diverse curricular, personal, and professional needs of students, teachers, and administrators. Candidates organize school library collections according to current library cataloging and classification principles and standards.

5.2 Professional Ethics

Candidates practice the ethical principles of their profession, advocate for intellectual freedom and privacy, and promote and model digital citizenship and responsibility. Candidates educate the school community on the ethical use of information and ideas.

5.3 Personnel, Funding, and Facilities

Candidates apply best practices related to planning, budgeting, and evaluating human, information, and physical resources. Candidates organize library facilities to enhance the use of information resources and services and to ensure equitable access to all resources for all users. Candidates develop, implement, and evaluate policies and procedures that support teaching and learning in school libraries.

5.4 Strategic Planning and Assessment

Candidates communicate and collaborate with students, teachers, administrators, and community members to develop a library program that aligns resources,

services, and standards with the school's mission. Candidates make effective use of data and information to assess how the library program addresses the needs of their diverse communities.
