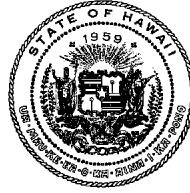

APPLICATION FOR NON-RENEWABLE PROVISIONAL HAWAII TEACHING LICENSE

NOTE: You must reapply for the non-renewable Provisional License each year, for up to three years. The Provisional License may not be recognized by your employer as meeting full licensure requirements.
