

PRAXIS TESTS INFORMATION SHEET

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board requires the following PRAXIS assessments:

PRAXIS I: Pre-Professional Skills Tests (PPST)*

All applicants must take the PPST in Reading, Writing and Mathematics. The computerized version of the PPST may be taken at participating Prometric Testing Centers **by appointment throughout the year.**

Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) PK-3, K-6, 5-9, or 7-12*

Applicants must take the PLT for the level of their teacher education program(s). Applicants with a middle level state approved program are required to complete the 5-9 version; early childhood applicants must take PLT PK-3. However, applicants with multiple grade levels are to select **ONLY** one level.

PRAXIS II: Content Area Tests*

Early Childhood (PK-3) and Elementary (K-6) applicants are required to take the tests listed for their area of preparation. Middle level applicants must select content tests aligned with student teaching. Secondary/Specialist applicants are required to take the subject area assessment(s) for the content area of their State Approved Teacher Education Program. If the teaching field is not listed, applicants are required to submit passing scores only for the PPST and PLT.

* **NOTE: NBPTS-certified teachers are exempt from all Praxis assessments.**
